- Dart - Cutter, 10 gun, 1810; 49 T, 47 ft; foundered, Dec 1813
- Dartmouth - 5 Rate, 36 gun, Aug 1813; 952 T, 145 ft; to 1854
- Dasher - Sloop, 18 gun, 1797 (at Bermuda); 402 T, 100 ft; to 1832
- Dauntless - Sloop, 18 gun, Nov 1804; 426 T, 109 ft; captured by French at Danzig, May 1807
- Dauntless - Sloop, 18 gun, Dec 1808; 423 T, 109 ft; to 1825
- Decade - 5 Rate, 36 gun; 915 T, 143 ft; ex French, taken off Cape Finisterre in Aug 1798; sold, Feb 1811
- Decouverte - Schooner, 8 gun; 165 T, 81 ft; ex French, taken at Hispaniola in Nov 1803; sold 1808
- Decouverte - Gun-Brig, 12 gun, 1807; 181 T, 80 ft; to 1816
- Decoy - Cutter, 10 gun, March 1810; 203 T, ?? ft; captured by French off Calais, March 1814
- Dedaigneuse - 5 Rate, 36 gun; 987 T, 144 ft; ex French, taken off Portugal in Jan 1801; to 1823
- Dee - 6 Rate, 20 gun, May 1814; 447 T, 108 ft; to 1819
- Defence - 3 Rate, 74 gun, 1763; 1603 T, 168 ft; wrecked on Jutland coast, Dec 1811
- Defence - 3 Rate, 74 gun, April 1815; 1754 T, 176 ft; to 1849
- Defender (Gunboat # 21) - May 1797; last listed in 1802
- Defender - Gun-Brig, 14 gun, July 1804; 179 T, 80 ft; wrecked off Folkestone, Dec 1809
- Defender - Lugger, 8 gun; 81 T, ?? ft; ex French privateer "Bonne Marseille", taken by "Royalist" in Dec 1809; sold, Sept 1814
- Defiance - 3 Rate, 74 gun, 1783; 1685 T, 169 ft; became a prison ship, Dec 1813
- Defiance - Gunboat, 4 gun, April 1794; 71 T, 70 ft; sold, Oct 1797
- Dego - 3 Rate, 64 gun; size ?; ex French, ex Maltese "Zacchari", taken in Sept 1800; sold at Malta in 1802
- Delft - 3 Rate, 64 gun; 1266 T, 157 ft; ex Dutch "Hercules", taken at Camperdown in Oct 1797; hulked, Aug 1802
- Delight - Sloop, 18 gun; 336 T, 97 ft; ex French "Sans Pareil", taken by "Mercury" off Sardinia in Jan 1801; sold, April 1805
- Delight - Brig-Sloop, 16 gun, June 1806; 300 T, 97 ft; stranded on Calabrian coast & captured by French, Jan 1808
- Delight - Sloop, 18 gun; 340 T, ?? ft; ex French "Friedland", taken by "Standard" off Cape Blanco in March 1808; sold, Sept 1814
- Delphinien - Brig-Sloop, 16 gun; 306 T, 97 ft; ex Danish, taken at Copenhagen in Sept 1807; to be renamed "Mondovi", but wasn't; wrecked on Dutch coast, Aug 1808
- Demerara - Schooner, 6 gun, 1804; 106 T, ?? ft; captured by French privateer in Caribbean, July 1804
- Demerara - Brig-Sloop, 18 gun; circa 220 T, ?? ft; ex French privateer "Cosmopoli", taken in 1806 by the inhabitants of Demerara (India), and given to English Navy in
