### **The Austrian War, 1859**

Because the Austrian Navy was of insignificant size, only a small part of the French Navy was needed to dominate the Adriatic. The following OB lists only the ships which went to the Adriatic (along with the allied Sardinian vessels).

Commander: Romain-Joseph Destosses, April-Aug 1859

- 1 x screw 3-decker - BRETAGNE (1855-66; 130 guns, 6770 T); was flagship
- 5 x Screw 2-deckers - ALGESIRAS (1855-69; 90 guns, 5040 T), ARCOLE
