

-VIII Reserve Corps

Mobilized in Aug 1914 with cadre from VIII Corps at Coblenz; initially commanded 15 and 16 Reserve ID

COMMANDERS: Wilhelm Egloffstein, Aug 1914-Jan 1915; Paul Fleck, Jan 1915-Sept 1916; Georg Wichura, Sept 1916-Nov 1918

BATTLES:

- 1914: Mobilized in the West - Neufchateau, Maas, Ist Marne, Ist Aisne
- 1915: Ist Champagne (with 22 Bde attached), II Champagne
- 1916: In the West (no major actions); became a HQ rather than a unit
- 1917: Was Sector HQ "Souchez", April-May - fought at Arras; HQ "Sierenz", June-Aug; HQ "Crepuy", from Aug
- 1918: Was HQ "Crepuy" until April - at Kaiserschlacht; became HQ "Vailly", April-June; fought at III Aisne and II Marne

-IX Reserve Corps

Mobilized in Aug 1914 with cadre from IX Corps at Altona; initially commanded 17 and 18 Reserve ID

COMMANDERS: Hans Boehn, Aug 1914-Feb 1917; Viktor Kühne, Feb-March 1917; Karl Dieffenbach, March 1917-Nov 1918

BATTLES:

- 1914: Mobilized on coast defense, then went to the West - Meldren, Ist Aisne (Noyon)
- 1915: In the West (no major actions)
- 1916: In summer became a HQ rather than a unit; Somme
- 1917: Was Sector HQ "Ypern", Feb-April; then fought at Arras; became HQ "Wystchate" for June-Nov, and again in Nov
- 1918: Was HQ "Wystchate" in Jan; later fought at Kaiser-schlacht, Armentieres (Lys), and Champagne-Meuse; was Sector HQ "Beaumont" for Oct-Nov

-Xth Reserve Corps

Mobilized in Aug 1914 with cadre from X Corps at Hannover; initially commanded 2nd Guard Reserve ID and 19 Reserve ID

COMMANDERS: Gunter Kirchbach, Aug 1914; Johannes Eben, Aug 1914-June 1915; Robert Kosch, June 1915-Aug 1916; Georg Fuchs, Aug-Oct 1916; Magnus Eberhardt, Oct 1916-Aug 1918; Arthur Gabain, Aug-Nov 1918

BATTLES:

- 1914: Mobilized in the West - Namur, Ist Guise, Ist Marne
- 1915: To the East in mid-year (to line on 4 July), with a new OB of 101 and 103 ID - Krasnostaw, Biskupice; to Balkans for conquest of Serbia
- 1916: In Feb became a HQ rather than a unit, and moved to the West - Verdun
