

- 1916: In the East
- 1917: Fought in the Battles of Zloczow and Riga; in fall moved to Italy - Caporetto, Udine
- 1918: Went to the West - Kaiserschlacht, Villers-Bretonneux, III Picardie, Albert, II Cambrai

-LII General Command

Formed in August 1916. For Aug 1916 to Jan 1917 was also called the "Danube Army", and unofficially still appeared as such throughout 1917

COMMANDER: Robert Kosch, Aug 1916-Nov 1918

- 1916-17: In the East - fought Romania; on Sereth River 1917
- 1918: On occupation service in the East
- 1919: Served in the Baltic until March, when dissolved

-LIII General Command

Formed in August 1916

COMMANDERS: Konstanz Heineccius, Aug 1916-March 1917; Manfred Richthofen, March 1917-Jan 1918; Leo Limbourg, Jan-Nov 1918

- 1916-17: In the East; fought in 1917 by Dunaburg (Dvinsk)
- 1918: Occupation service in the East; moved to Serbia and the Danube in the fall

-LIV General Command

Formed in September 1916

COMMANDERS: Viktor Kühne, Sept 1916-Feb 1917; Richard Kraewel, Feb 1917; Eduard Liebert, Feb-June 1917; Max Müller, June 1917-Jan 1918; Alexander Larisch, Jan-Nov 1918

- 1916: In the East - Sarduk, Targu Jiu, Arges, Rimnicul
- 1917: Putna River; went to the West in spring - was Sector HQ "Liese" for April-May, and at II Aisne; HQ "Crepuy", May to Aug; was HQ "Vailly" from Aug
- 1918: Was HQ "Vailly" until April, then again became HQ "Crepuy" for April-June; at III Aisne, II Somme, Albert, II Cambrai

-LV General Command

Formed in Oct 1916 from "Corps Bernhardi" (which had been created during the emergency caused by Brussilov's offensive in June 1916)

COMMANDER: Friedrich Bernhardi, (June) Oct 1916 to Nov 1918

- 1916: In the East; was Sector HQ "Kovel" from Dec
- 1917: Was still HQ "Kovel"
- 1918: Was still HQ "Kovel" until Feb, then moved to the West; at Armentieres (Lys); no major actions thereafter
