

3. Units

NOTE - For the Divisions, etc., these notes cover the Balkan and Turkish Wars as well as World War I.

Higher HQ for 1917-18

- Commanders-in-Chief - Panajotis Danglis, Jan-Nov 1918; Leonidas Paraskevopoulos, Nov 1918 (only)
- Chiefs of staff - Anastasios Charalambis, June-Dec 1917; George Leonardopoulos, Dec 1917-Feb 1918; Theodore Pangalos, Feb-Nov 1918

Corps HQ for 1917-18

- Corps of National Defense - Epaminondas Zymbrakas, May 1917-Nov 1918. This HQ oversaw the Venizelist units
- Corps "Alpha" (I) - Leonidas Paraskevopoulos, April-Nov 1918. Went to the front in April 1918
- Corps "Beta" (II) - Anastasios Charalambis, June to?? 1918; Constantine Miliotis Komninos, ?? to Nov 1918. Went to the front in Sept 1918

-1st Infantry Division

- In 1909 had 1 Bde [IR 4, 5], 2 Bde [IR 2, 3], Evzone Bns # 4 and 6; Cav Regt # 1, Arty Regt # 1
- In 1912, HQ at Larissa; IR # 2, 4, 5; Evzone Bns # 4, 6; Cav Regt # 1; Arty Regt # 1
- Balkan Wars - Fought with IR # 2, 4, 5 and Arty Regt # 1; in 1912 was in the Thessaly Army; in 1913 fought Bulgaria
- In 1914, HQ was still at Larissa; IR # 4, 5; Evzone Regt # 38 (also called "1st Evzones"); Arty Bn # 1
- Mobilized in Oct 1917 at Larissa (Alpha Corps District); to front in March 1918 with IR # 4, 5, 38 (1st Evzone), Arty Bns # 1.A and 1.B, and Cav Sqdn # 1. Fought in fall 1918 under Corps Alpha
- In April 1919 went to the Anatolian front with the same OB, minus the cavalry sqdn

-2nd Infantry Division

- In 1909 had 3 Bde [IR 1, 7], 4 Bde [IR 8, 11]; Evzone Bns # 1 and 2; Cav Regt # 2, Arty Regt # 2
- In 1912, HQ at Athens; IR # 1, 3, 7; Evzone Bn # 1; Cav Regt # 2; Arty Regt # 2
- Balkan Wars - Fought with IR # 1, 3, 7 and Arty Regt # 2; in 1912 in Thessaly Army until Nov, then moved to Epirus Army; in 1913 fought Bulgaria
- In 1914, HQ still at Athens; IR # 1, 7, 34; Arty Bn # 2
- Mobilized in March 1918 at Athens (Alpha Corps District); to front in June with IR # 1, 7, 34 and Arty Bns # 2.A, 2.B, and Cav Sqdn # 2. Fought in fall 1918 under Corps Alpha
- For Jan-April 1919 in Russia (at Odessa except for IR 34 at Sevastopol)
