

**-Group "K"**

A Corps-level HQ, created during mobilization to command 16 & 17 ID on the Bulgarian frontier; in Dec 1940 merged into V Corps

- Led by George Kosmas, Nov-Dec 1940 (hence called the "K" Group); briefly led by Panajotis Demestichas in Dec 1940 (he became CO of V Corps after the Group merged into V Corps)

The Divisions -

(Note - In addition to the IR shown, each Inf Div had an Arty Regt with the same number as the division (1<sup>st</sup> Regt in 1<sup>st</sup> ID, etc.)

**-1st Infantry Division**

Pre-war HQ at Larissa, in II Corps District; mobilized on Albanian front with II Corps; had IR # 2, 4, 5 plus Evzone Regt # 42 (i.e., four inf regts), plus Arty Regt # 1; by April 1941 reorganized with IR # 4, 5 & 16; stayed on the Albanian front with II Corps until the end; in 4/41 was led by B. Urachnos

**-2nd Infantry Division**

Pre-war HQ at Athens, in I Corps District; mobilized on Albanian front with I Corps; had IR # 1, 3, 34 and AR # 2; by April 1941 reorganized with four IR (# 3, 34, 36 & 39); stayed on the Albanian front under I Corps; in 4/41 led by G. Laudos

**-3rd Infantry Division**

Pre-war HQ at Patras, in I Corps District; mobilized on Albanian front in I Corps; had IR # 6, 12, 39 and AR # 3; by April 1941 reorganized with four IR (# 6, 12, 24, 40); always stayed on the Albanian front in I Corps; in 4/41 led by G. Bakos

**-4th Infantry Division**

Pre-war HQ at Nauplion, in I Corps District; mobilized on Albanian front in I Corps; had IR # 8, 9, 11 and AR # 4; stayed on the Albanian front; in March 1941 was with II Corps, in April with the West Macedonia Army; led in 4/41 by K. Boulakos

**-5th Infantry Division (the "Crete" Division)**

Pre-war was stationed on Crete as an independent Div; mobilized in General Reserve; had IR # 14, 43, 44 and AR # 5; left Crete when the English agreed to take over the garrison duties; went to the Albanian front in Nov 1940, and achieved a reputation as the best Div in the Army; with II Corps in Albania in March-April 1941; led in 4/41 by G. Papageorgiou

**-6th Infantry Division**

Pre-war HQ at Serrai, III Corps District; mobilized on the Bulgarian frontier with just two IR (# 19 & 21) plus AR # 6; by April 1941 had also gained IR # 25; moved to the Albanian front in
