

- In June 1919 went to the Anatolian front with the same OB, minus the cavalry sqdn

### **-3rd Infantry Division**

- In 1909 had 5 Bde [IR 6, 10], 6 Bde [IR 9, 12]; Evzone Bns # 3 and 7; Cav Regt # 3, Arty Regt # 3
- In 1912, HQ at Missolunghi; IR # 6, 10, 12; Evzone Bns # 3 and 7; Cav Regt # 3; Arty Regt # 3
- Balkan Wars - Fought with IR # 6, 10, 12 and Cav Regt # 3; in 1912 with the Thessaly Army; in 1913 fought Bulgaria
- In 1914, HQ at Patras; IR # 6 & 12 and Evzone Regt # 39 (or "2nd Evzones"); Arty Bn # 3
- NOTE - This and other units from the Morea (Corps District Beta) were the most loyal to King Constantine; however, they fought well against the Bulgarians when finally ordered to do so
- Mobilized in May 1918 at Patras (Beta Corps District), and went to the front in the same month with IR # 6, 12, 39 (2 Evzone) and Arty Bns # 3.A, 3.B and Cav Sqdn # 3; fought in fall 1918 under 3rd French Group
- In June 1920 went to the Anatolian front; had the same infantry, no cavalry; artillery was Arty Bns # 9.A, 9.B

### **-4th Infantry Division**

- In 1912, HQ at Nauplia; IR # 8, 9, 11; Evzone Bn # 2; no cavalry; Arty Regt # 4
- Balkan Wars - Fought with IR # 8, 9, 11; in 1912 with Thessaly Army, moved to the Epirus Army in Jan 1913; fought Bulgaria later in 1913
- In 1914, HQ still at Nauplia; IR # 8, 11, 35; Arty Bn # 4
- Mobilized in June 1918 at Nauplia (Beta Corps District); went to the front in August with IR # 8, 11, 35 and Arty Bns # 4.A, 4.B and Cav Sqdn # 4; in fall 1918 fought under 4th French Group
- In March 1921 went to the Anatolian front; had same OB, minus cavalry

### **-5th Infantry Division**

- Initially a reserve unit raised during the mobilization for the Balkan Wars; it had IR # 16, 22 & 23 (each of 2 bns) and served in the Thessaly Army; in Feb 1913 moved to the Epirus Army; fought Bulgaria later in 1913
- In 1914, as a standing unit, had HQ at Drama; IR # 22, 23, 37 (# 37 was also called "3rd Cretan"); Arty Bn # 5
- Dissolved in winter 1915-16 as a result of the establishment of the Salonika front and the disarming of Greek troops by the Bulgarians
- Not reformed until Jan 1921; at that time the "Crete" ID (on the Anatolian front) became 5th ID; it had IR # 33, 43 and 44 plus Arty Bns # 5.A & 5.B
