

- Initially a reserve unit raised during the mobilization for the Balkan Wars; it had IR # 17 and 18 (each of 2 bns) plus the Combined Evzone Regt (became 1st Evzone Regt; over Evzone Bns # 5 and 7); served in the Thessaly Army; in Jan 1913 moved to the Epirus Army; fought Bulgaria later in 1913
- In 1914, as a standing unit, had HQ at Errai [Serres]; IR # 16, 17, 18; Arty Bn # 6
- Doesn't appear for 1915-21; presumably was dissolved around 1916
- Next appears in OB for 1922, when it was observing the Turks in Thrace; at that time it had IR # 19, 20 and 21

-7th Infantry Division

- Initially a reserve unit raised during the mobilization for the Balkan Wars; it had IR # 19, 20 & 21 (each of 2 bns), and was in the Thessaly Army; in 1913 fought Bulgaria
- In 1914, as a standing unit, had HQ at Kavala; IR # 19, 20, 21 (# 21 was also called "2nd Cretan"); Arty Bn # 7
- In early 1916 was mostly dissolved when the Bulgarians advanced to Kavala and disarmed the Greek troops in the area; about 2,000 men withdrew to Salonika and joined the Venizelists
- Not reformed until Dec 1920; at that time the "Archipelago" ID (on the Anatolian front) became 7th ID; it had IR # 22, 23, 37 (ex Archipelago IR # 4, 5, 6) plus Arty Bns # 7.A and 7.B

-8th Infantry Division

- Was formed in the field in Dec 1912 from troops in the Army of Epirus - commanded IR # 15 and the "Crete" IR (each had 3 bns) plus an Evzone "Brigade" (of 4 bns; it became 2nd Evzone Regt); in 1913 fought Bulgaria, arriving gradually at the front
- In 1914, as a standing unit, had HQ at Preveza; IR # 10, 15, 24; Arty Bn # 8
- Retained throughout 1914-18, but not mobilized; in 1918 was still at Preveza (Epirus) under Corps Epsilon; was left at home because it was considered unreliable; as a cadre, it had about 3,000 men
- In 1922 was observing the Turks in Thrace, with a different OB; at that time it had IR # 13, 15 and 50 (?)

-9th Infantry Division

- Formed in April 1913 for the Epirus garrison (and hence wasn't engaged against Bulgaria); had IR # 24, 25 & 26 (each of 2 bns)
- In 1914, as a standing unit; had HQ at Janina; IR # 25, 26; Evzone Regt # 40 (or "3rd Evzones"); Arty Bn # 9
- Mobilized in March 1918 at Janina (Corps Epsilon); went to the front in June 1918 with IR # 25, 26, 40 (3rd Evzone) and Arty Bns # 9.A, 9.B and Cav Sqdn # 9; was in reserve at the start of Sept offensive, and never engaged (stayed by Florina in Sept & Oct and was still training when the war ended)
- In April 1921 went to the Anatolian front with the same OB, minus the cavalry sqdn
