

**-1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division**

HQ at Budapest (I Corps); until mobilized in Oct 1942 it had 1 and 31 IR plus 1 Arty Regt. Thereafter it was with occupation troops in Russia, with a varying OB - thus in 12/42 it had HQ of 33 IR (Bn II/33 plus 31 & 41 March Bns) and HQ of 252 IR (Bns II/40 & I/41 plus 40 March Bn); in 7/43 it had HQ of 33 IR (Bns II/33 & II/37 plus 41 March Bn) and HQ of 46 IR (Bns II/40 & III/46 plus 44 March Bn)

**1941:** Fought Yugoslavia under I Corps

**1942:** In Dec went to Ukraine as rear area troops

**1943:** In rear areas of Ukraine (west of Kursk); in Sept the Russians neared Kiev, and the Germans forced the Div to enter the line to oppose them; it was soon smashed because of its poor artillery and equipment; returned to rear area service under VII Corps (in west Ukraine)

**1944:** In Jan was near Pinsk; in spring moved to Galicia and served near Lemberg  
Dissolved in May 1944 - personnel to 5, 12 and 23 ID

**-2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Brigade** [As a Division was # 102]

HQ at Budapest (I Corps); when mobilized for Russia in Oct 1941 the 2 Bde was redesignated 102 Bde and in Feb 1942 became the nominal 102 Div. Prior to mobilization had 2 & 32 IR plus 2 Arty Regt; in Russia had varying units (as of 11/42 these were HQ of 40 IR with Bns II/40, I/42 & III/42, and HQ of 53 IR with Bns II/43, III/43 and II/53).

**1941:** Fought Yugoslavia under IV Corps; to Ukraine garrison in October

**1942-43:** As # 102 was in rear areas, usually near Bryansk & Gomel (original HQ at Neschiv); retreated to Kiev area in 1943

Dissolved in July 1943 (personnel to 23 Div)

**-3<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Brigade** [Never a division]

HQ at Budapest (I Corps); had 15 & 45 IR plus 3 Arty Regt. Was never mobilized; dissolved in August 1941 - personnel to IX Corps and the Mobile Corps

**-4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division**

HQ at Szekesfehervar (II Corps); had 3 & 33 IR plus 4 Arty Regt. Was never mobilized; dissolved in August 1943 as part of the final reorganization

**-5<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division**

HQ at Győr (II Corps); when mobilized for Russia in Oct 1941 became 105 Bde (in 2/42 became 105 Div). In Aug 1943 became 5 Reserve ID. Prior to 10/41 had 16 & 46 IR plus 5 Arty Regt. While serving as # 105 had a varying OB (i.e. in 12/41 had HQ of 32 IR with Bns II/32, II/33 and one other plus HQ of HQ of 46 IR with Bns III/46, II/52 and one other). From 8/43 again had a fixed OB - 33, 46 & 52 IR; 34, 58 & 82 Arty Bns; 5 Recce Bn

**1941-43:** To Ukraine garrison in Oct 1941 (first HQ at Chernigov); briefly in line in Feb
