

In March 1803 the unit was split into two regular "Mounted" Regts - the Lithuanian Mounted (this entry) and the Tartar Mounted [see 125]; each had 5 sqdns. In Nov 1807 this unit became the Lithuania Uhlan Regt; in 1833 = UR # 5, 1882 = DR # 14; from 1907 was UR Lithuania # 5

**HQ:** In 1798 at Eshpuky (?), Lithuania; in 1914 at Simbirsk

**ASSIGNED:** In 5 Div, 1807; 4 Cav Div, 1812; 1 Uhlan Div, 1813-18; Lithuania Uhlan Div, 1818-33; 3 (Lt) Cav Div, 1833-57; 3 Cav Div, 1857-75; 5 Cav Div, 1875-1918

#### **-6th Volhynia Uhlan Regiment**

Formed in April 1807 as Volhynia Mounted Regt [144]; in Nov 1807 became Uhlans. In 1833 = UR # 6, in 1882 = DR # 17; from 1907 = UR Volhynia # 6

**HQ:** In 1914 at Tsyekhanov (Poland) but temporarily stationed at Lomzha

**ASSIGNED:** 6 Cav Div, 1812; 3 Uhlan Div, 1813-14; 2 Uhlan Div, 1814-18; Lithuania Uhlan Div, 1818-33; 3 (Lt) Cav Div, 1833-57; 3 Cav Div, 1857-75; 6 Cav Div, 1875-1918

#### **-7th Olviopol Uhlan Regiment**

(King Alfonso XIII of Spain's)

Formed in Oct 1817 as 1st Bug Uhlan Regt (or "Orange" UR) [153]; cadre was from the old 3 & 4 Ukraine UR plus levies from the Bug Cossack Host. In June 1830 = UR
