*** ACTIONS:**

1943: Entered the line near Leningrad at the end of the year

1944: Leningrad-Novgorod Offensive [*], 14 Jan-1 March - advanced to Pskov area; stayed in same sector through summer; Battle of Pskov-Ostrov [*], 11-31 July; was in Estonia at the start of the Baltic Offensive [*], 14 to around 24 September (capture of Reval); later in September joined 2 Shock Army for rest of the war; left the Baltic area to join Stavka reserves at end of Sept and then joined 2 Belarus Front (by 1 Nov)

1945: East Prussia campaign [*], 13 Jan-10 Feb - engaged at Marienburg and on the lower Vistula; advance from Graudenz and Danzig, Feb-March; conquest of East Pomerania [*], 10 Feb-4 April (to Stettin); Berlin operation [*], 16 April-8 May - advanced along the Baltic coast from Stettin to Stralsund

*** ACTIONS:**

1943: At end of the year was in Leningrad Front reserves

1944: Leningrad-Novgorod Offensive [*], 14 Jan-1 March - advanced to the Estonian border in Feb; fought near Narva from Feb to July; advanced in Estonia in Aug and Sept then entered Stavka reserves where it joined 21 Army for rest of the war; in Dec the Army joined 1st Ukraine Front south of Warsaw

1945: Vistula-Oder Offensive [*], 19 Jan-3 Feb (in reserve at the start, then advanced through Kielce to Silesia); Lower Silesia [*], 18-24 Feb; Upper Silesia [*], 15-31 March; Prague Operation [*], 6-11 May
