

-9th Infantry Division

Formed in late 1964 and fought at Binh Gia (near Saigon) in Dec 1964; was always engaged against III ARVN Corps, usually in the area NW of Saigon. From late 1968 it kept its "VC" designation, but most of the personnel were actually regulars from North Vietnam. Fought at Bien Hoa in spring 1969 and in Tay Ninh province in 1972; still existed in Jan 1973, but that time all the units and troops were from the North. At that time it commanded three Inf Regts - 95-C, 271 & 272
